

BQ.2 Chicagoland Marathon 2022

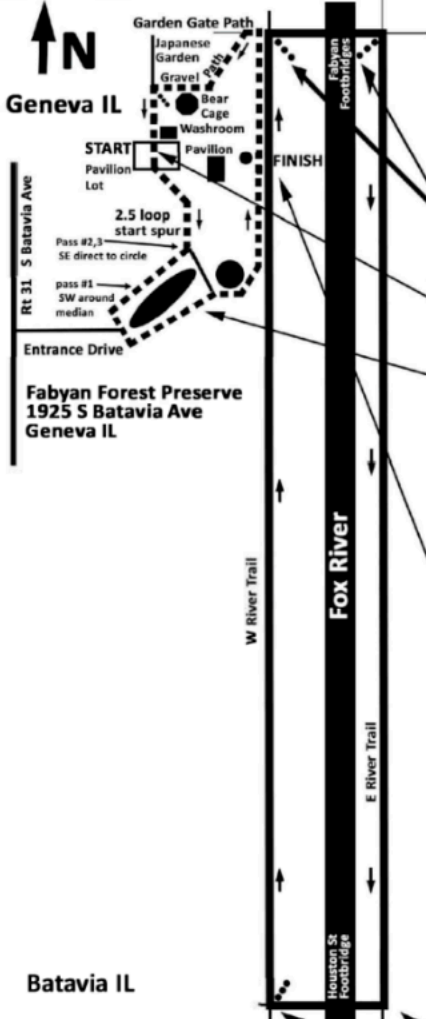
- START / FINISH: Geneva IL
- FINISH TO START DISTANCE: 200 Feet
- Includes: Geneva, Batavia
- Start spur, then loop 8 times,
- from W River Trail N to Fabyan footbridges,
- E to E River Trail,
- S to Houston St footbridge
- W to W River Trail
- N to Finish

- Course is paved road and bike trail with many 'S' curves
- The full width of roads and trail was used to measure the shortest path on the curves
- Road crossings were measured diagonally to obtain the shortest path
- Measured path used gravel path on Start Spur as shown
- Measured path stayed on road, paved trail and sidewalk at all other times

Cone a line SW from NE Fabyan Crossing corner to prevent runners from cutting the corner

Cone a line SE from NW Fabyan Crossing corner to prevent runners from cutting the corner

START: Fabyan Forest Preserve West
 99' 08" S of S edge of 1st building N of N edge of pavilion parking lot

2.5 LOOP START SPUR
 S on N Lot Access Rd
 SW around median to Entrance Drive (pass #1 only) or SE to circle (#2,3)
 NE staying SE of circle to W River Path
 N past Finish Line to Garden Gate Path / River Crossing
 W to Gravel Path
 S and W on path around Japanese Garden to
 MARK at Access Road E edge and even with N wall of bear cage staying N of line of cones S and E from that mark
 turn left (S) along road past starting point
 Repeat start spur loop as a 2nd loop with pass #2,3 adjustment at circle
 Repeat 1st portion to end of Start Spur / beginning of Main Loop at Finish

2.5 LOOP START SPUR ENDS & MAIN LOOP BEGINS:
 same spot as Finish Line

FINISH: Fabyan Forest Preserve

 N of pavilion and W of river trail
 after completing 8 main loops
